2.6.2. Attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution.

The college has devised a mechanism to assess the level of attainment of course outcomes. Regarding the method of measuring the attainment of POs, PSOs and COs; the institution applies multiple evaluation tools and methods. The course outcomes are monitored through the performance in internal and semester-end examinations. Other activities such as class tests, quizzes, and student seminars are also considered for the attainments. Each department analyses the performance of its students in the departmental meetings. The head of the department assesses the course outcomes as per the scheme provided. For net CO attainment, 40% weightage for CIE and 60% weightage for SEE is considered. There are three attainment levels namely Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3. Further, a target score has been set to decide the level of attainment. The attainment levels and target score have been set by each stream depending upon the syllabi. The indirect method, student and alumni feedback is also used for course outcome assessment. These courses help to develop their skills and that helps to secure their jobs. The attainment of programme outcomes is evaluated through students' progression and placement.
